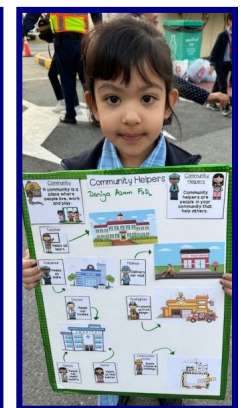
Term 2 Fees

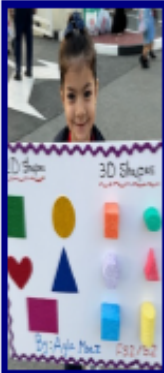
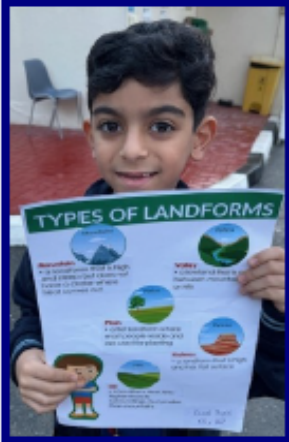

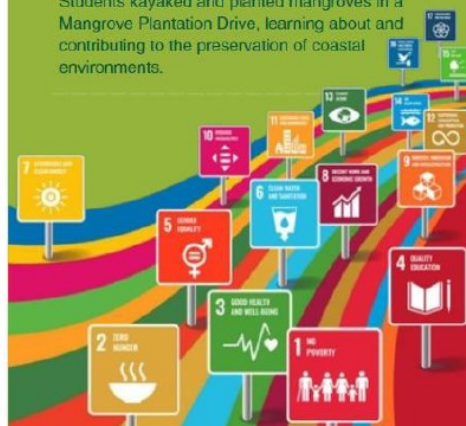


WSS GREEN FINGERS PROGRAM

It will still be shining bright.







