The Authorities are strongly recommending that all students over age 12 years are fully vaccinated (both doses) for their own safety. If your child attends the Blended programme (Face-to-Face), we are now able to provide water coolers, but please send in a personal water bottle & snack daily. The canteen will not be open. Full T1 fees must be paid before any student has their class confirmed to be admitted for the new academic year (for both Blended & Online DL (Distance Learning). Please Budget accordingly—there will be no Payment Plans in T1 (no exceptions). Thank you. 				
Sunday 12th Sep- tember	• Deadline to clear T1 fees & submit any outstand- ing documents (new admissions) to keep your booked seat. After this date we will assume that you do not want your seat & will offer it to the Waiting List. Please email the Principal if you need a week's extension.

Secondary Section News; Personalisation of Learning!

Our key School Development Plan targets for last 2 years have centered around the personalisation of learning for our students, to improve their progress and achievement. This includes the rigorous use of specific assessment data, such as CAT4 bias & Progress Test results to ensure we include appropriate challenge and skill development in lessons and the curriculum. Last year in a Key Stage 3 (KS3; Y7-9) focus group, we added a third dimension to our critical data set to fully understand individual learning needs to support the best possible achievement outcomes; we added PASS (Performance Assessment of Self-care Skills) data to inform the way we differentiate and personalize individual learning activities. PASS is an assessment that looks at a student's attitude to school, teachers, self and learning. Research shows that learning has an emotional and psychological dimension, therefore understanding and managing attitudes, beliefs and values can help us unlock a child's learning potential.

The results of this KS3 initiative showed marked improvement in learning across the focus group with the addition of PASS data into lesson planning to further personalize the students' learning experience. We will be extending the initiative into additional groups across the school over the coming academic year.
