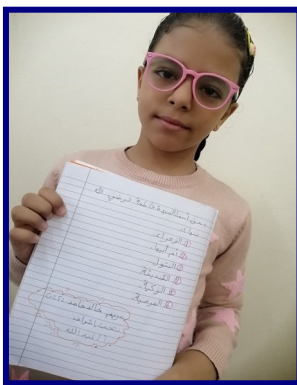
Dear WSS Parents,
