Do please inform the school clinic in case your child catches COVID, or is quarantined due to being a close contact. The Authorities require that we submit a report to them for all such cases. Thank you.

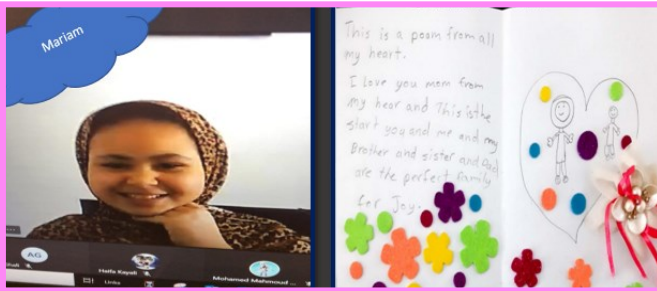
Re-enrolment for September 2021

Re-enrolment for September 2021

A big thank you to all parents who have already re-enrolled. If you have not yet re-enrolled, please note that we do understand that parents' plans for September 2021 may not yet be fixed. However, since we are in recruitment season for new Teachers, have to budget according to student numbers & order books, we do need to know if you require seats for your child for September. If we do not have a clear picture of enrolment, we will not be able to prepare our children's learning programme for September. **Please complete the online re-enrolment process at the earliest** to avoid lost seats, last minute inconvenience & stress for you. Thank you.

Sunday 11th April first day back for T3 for students. T3 fees due. Educational Programme from 11/4/21 will be back to Blended/100% Online RLP as per parents T2 option choice. However, this is subject to Authority change.
Mon. 12th April	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> System re-enrolment facility open. Deadline book your seat online & also to pay the AED500/- Seat Booking Fee is Monday 12th April. After this date seats will be given to the Waiting List. Seats Booking Fee can only be paid subject to clearance of full T2 fees. Seats will not be held beyond the last day of T3 if T3 fees remain pending. Any paid Seat Booking Fee would be lost. Seats would be given to the Waiting list, & if parents decide later that they want a seat, this would be subject to availability, & not guaranteed. You may change your mind about enrolment at WSS at any time, however the seat booking fee is non-refundable (but deductible from T1 Fees, Sept-Dec. '21).
Sunday 20th June	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Deadline to apply for a TC if leaving WSS is Sunday 20th June. After this date the GRE is not available for late TC processing & there would be delays in processing.
Thurs. 1st July	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students' last day of the academic year (TBC). The new Academic Year will start from Sunday 29th August (TBC)

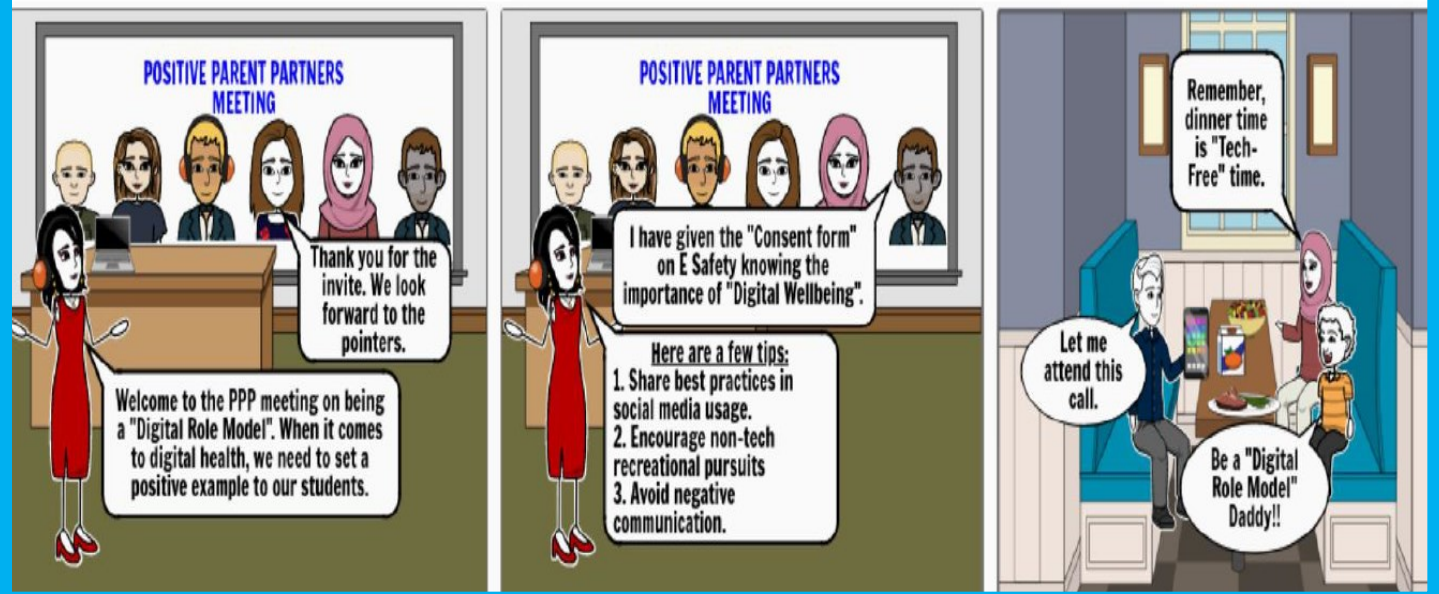

ACCCEPTING
Only accept messages and emails from people you know. Inform your parents about messages from unknowns.

RELIABLE
Do not believe everything you see on the internet. People can lie about who they are and what they are saying. Use only reliable websites.

TELL
Tell your parents or a trusted adult whenever you feel uncomfortable about something, if there is a bullying issue, or just have a bad feeling towards something.

- Ministry of Higher Education (MoHE) requirement for University admissions in the UAE .
- For Jobs in the UAE mainland, equivalency of high school certificate is required.

Requirements for University Application in Federal Universities

UAE national children of Emirati mothers who completed secondary education need to fulfil a number of other requirements, which include:

- completing General School Certificate (GSC) or its equivalent and achieving the score set by the desired independent university
- completing the unified online application for higher education and uploading all related documents through the 'Student portal'
- undergoing a medical check-up.

Private schools graduates

UAE nationals who completed secondary education from private schools and are seeking admission to a university need to fulfil admission requirements. Further, high school graduates from private schools, which follow curricula other than the public curriculum, must have their certificates equalized.

HOW TO OBTAIN EQUIVALENCY CERTIFICATE?

Provide the following to Ministry of Education at the MOE service center:

Documents:

1. High school certificate for Grade 12 / year 13 to MOE
2. Transcript
3. Passport copy + visa copy
4. Emirates Identification (EID Copy)
