



KG1 (FS2) Expectations on Entry

Date:

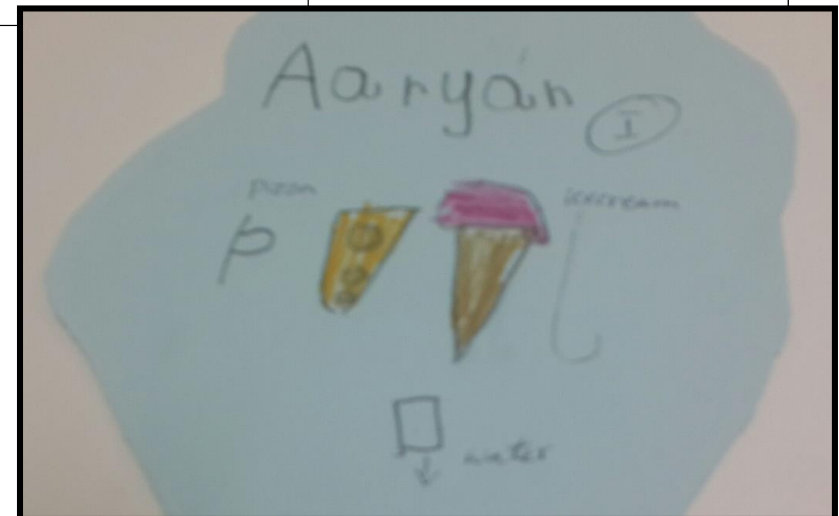
- In UAE, a child may join FS2 if he/she is 4years by 31st August.
- KG1 is equivalent to FS2 in a school that runs the English National Curriculum.
- Therefore, expectations for entry are in line with FS2 expectations in UK.
- A child would need to attend FS1 or nursery prior to joining FS2, in order to have basic foundation literacy, social & numeracy skills.

A child should be able to achieve at least expected or exceeding level in age band of 3-4years

A child can write his/her name & copy key words. He/she can write the initial sounds of words.





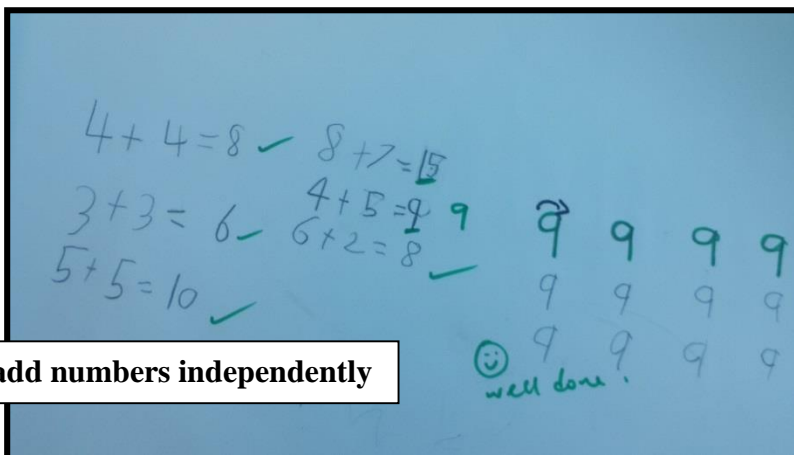
KG2 (Year 1) Expectations on Entry

Date:

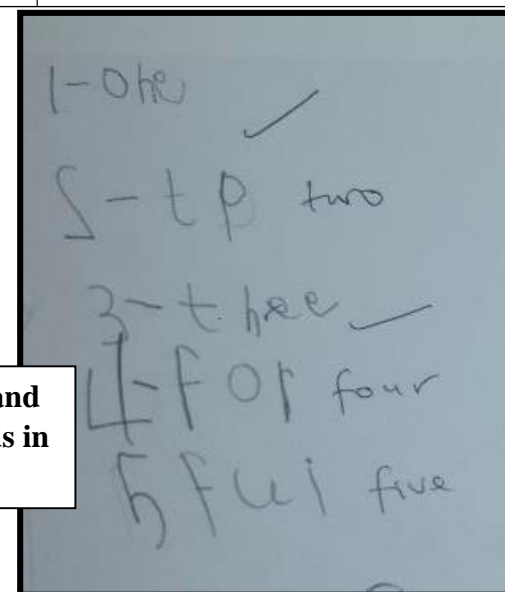
- In UAE, a child may join Year1 when he/she turns 5 years of age by 31st August.
- KG2 is equivalent to Year 1 in a school that runs the English National Curriculum.
- Therefore, expectations for KG2 entry are in line with Year 1 expectations in UK.
- A child should be able to achieve at expected level of Early Learning Goals, when the child turns 5 years.
