### **Term 3 Fees**

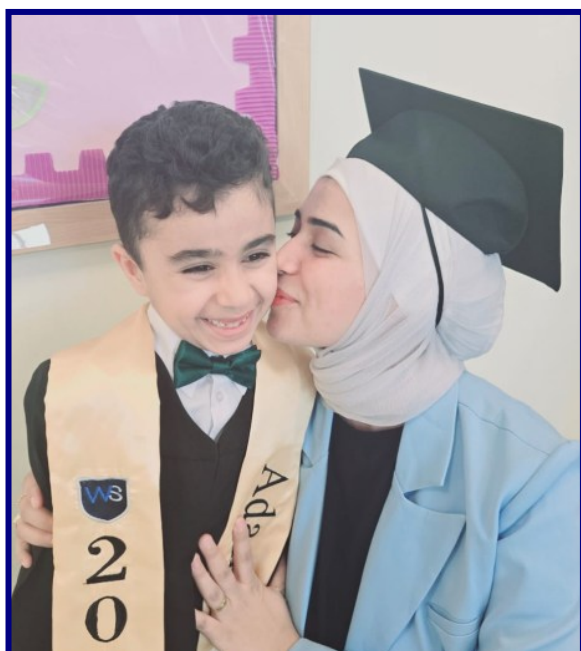
