Monday 29/8/22	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Please note that T1 Fees need to be cleared in full before any student joins. There are no T1 Payment Plans. If your child received 2 Warning Letters last academic year, the parent needs to sign a Conditional Admission Letter before any class is assigned for the child to rejoin school for the new academic year. As per updated Authority Circular #25 received on 30/5/22, students must join within the first week of the new academic year, or lose their booked seat to the Waiting List, unless you pay full T1 fees to hold your child's seat. There is no fee rise again this year, however, moving forwards, please see the updated, approved Seat Reservation/Re-enrollment fees as published in this NL#1. It takes one working day for a child's name to appear on the Classlist for the Teacher to accept the child into class. Therefore, to avoid delays of admission into class, we recommend that T1 fees are paid in full by latest Thursday 25th August.

10. I would prefer my child to use cash, is this still an option?

11. My child has lost his card, what should I do?

As this is the School ID / STS Card this should be reported to the school, once a replacement is issued the card will automatically be updated for use in the canteen

12. Will I receive a notification when my balance is low?

We are currently adding this feature to our system and will be rolling out in the coming weeks.


Good morning, hope you are doing good.
