On 14/11/23, WSS hosted a team of senior colleagues from our sister GEMS Westminster schools for an intensive, oneday inspection Review. The

focus area of this Review was 'Challenge & Personalisation of Learning in the Classroom'. We are very proud of our education team & super students for a very successful result; student behaviour & attitude to learning were judged to be 'outstanding' & 'A credit to them, their parents & school'. The Review team were impressed with how confidently the students were able to talk about thier targets & learning. Other identified strengths of the school were the consistency & planning of lesson structure, the use of data to support learning, & AFL. Areas noted for further development were the scaffolding & support for lower-level students & the further personalisation of marking, which we will continue to work on.

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Whole School News; PIRLS 2021 Assessment Report!

What is PIRLS?

PIRLS is an international study of reading, focusing on the development of students from 'learning to read' to 'reading to learn'.

In 2021, students in Grades 4 and 5 in over 60 different countries participated in PIRLS. While Grade 4 students are the target population for PIRLS, the COVID-19 pandemic and school closures meant that some participating countries tested Grade 5 students instead of Grade 4 students.

What does PIRLS assess?

PIRLS assessments contain reading literacy content common across participating countries' curricula, ensuring that comparisons between countries are as fair as possible.

PIRLS examines students' reading achievement in relation to different curriculum types, instructional practices and school environments.

PIRLS questionnaires for teachers and principals explore what is intended to be taught in reading literacy and how it is actually taught. The questionnaires for students and parents and guardians also provide contextual information that helps us to interpret the results of the reading assessment.

Why is PIRLS important?

A reading survey conducted in 2016 led to the creation a 10-year National Policy for Reading to encourage the habit of reading among all age groups and to ensure 80 per cent of children and 50 per cent of adults read actively. In addition, 2016 was declared as the "Year of Reading" by Late HH Sheikh Khalifa bin Zayed Al Nahyan, President of the UAE, to cultivate a strong culture of reading in the country. A similar National Reading Strategy was adopted by Shaikh Mohammad Bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice-President and Prime Minister of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai, this and several such initiatives by the government and associated entities in the different Emirates have worked tirelessly to bring reading under a spotlight to develop stronger reading habits and amongst students, parents and teachers in the UAE.

PIRLS provides important information for policy development, to foster public accountability, to allow areas of progress or decline in achievement to be identified and monitored, and to address concerns for equity.

PIRLS provides schools with an opportunity to identify trends in the performance of student subpopulations such as male and female students, and disadvantaged students. International assessments can help confirm, or otherwise, trends already recognised in schools or nationally.

Whole School News; Updated Parent Handbook—Privacy

FYI, we have slightly updated our Safeguarding Policy, as published in our comprehensive Parent Handbook, published on the school website & accessed through the QR code on p3 of the weekly Newsletter (see p58).

Privacy

Privacy is a right for all. If you have any Safeguarding concerns, please report them immediately to the Principal. Privacy expectations include:

- The confidentiality of information. Staff will not share the personal information of self, or others in the WSS community, & will only discuss about a child with the respective parents & concerned staff. Parents are also requested to respect the confidentiality of school, staff & others' personal information, both F2F & online
- Physical privacy; no student, whatever the age, should be required to change clothing in front of others. If a
 young child requires help changing in school (such as after a toilet accident), this would be done in the privacy
 of the washroom cubicle by a lady staff, & the utmost care would be taken to maintain modesty & avoid
 intimate touch. Parents are requested to encourage their children to have the confidence to say "No, I am
 not comfortable with that!" & to voice any concern in a sensitive situation.
- Photography; it is not allowed by law to take or share pictures of others without their permission. It is
 not allowed for parents/guests to take pictures around school, or of other people's children, except in
 usual group situations such as of your child's Assembly show.


Business Club members Upinder (Y13GD) & Afnan (Y13BS) shares the following about the Business Club Vision & Mission:
