need lots of sleep, encouragement & healthy food—we are sure that with your loving support they will do very well & enjoy the pride of well-earned success!







Tournament Report

GEMS Westminster School, Sharjah, proudly hosted the Northern Emirates Cup – Season 4 (2025), uniting 15 schools from across the region in a celebration of sportsmanship, teamwork, and athletic excellence. The four-day football tournament, featuring both girls' and boys' categories, aimed to promote physical fitness, discipline, and inter-school collaboration.

The event showcased remarkable participation, flawless organization, and immense enthusiasm from students, teachers, and staff, making this edition one of the most memorable to date.

Day-wise Overview

- O Day 1 Monday, 3rd November 2025 (Girls' Matches) The tournament commenced with 15 schools participating in the girls' categories, involving 360 students, 50+ PE teachers, and 4 match officials. The league-stage matches highlighted high energy, coordination, and teamwork. Support from the school leadership team and the PE Department ensured a smooth and engaging start.
- O Day 2 Tuesday, 4th November 2025 (Boys' Matches) Day two featured 382 boys competing across multiple age groups. The day was filled with exciting fixtures and skillful performances, balancing competitive spirit with fair play, coordinated efficiently by staff, officials, and volunteers.
- O Day 3 Wednesday, 5th November 2025 (Girls' Grand Final Day) Eight schools with 192 student participants, 20 PE teachers, 4 officials, and the WSS PE team attended the Girls' Grand Finals. Support from 25 student volunteers, 25 junior school students, and 25 primary student volunteers contributed to seamless ground management and event logistics. The finals reflected top-tier performance, sportsmanship, and teamwork.
- O Day 4 Thursday, 6th November 2025 (Boys' Grand Final Day) The Boys' Grand Finals brought together 10 schools, 192 student players, 20 PE teachers, 4 match officials, 25 student volunteers, and 26 junior school students. Matches were highly competitive, demonstrating the finest youth football talent, played with intensity, discipline, and exemplary sportsmanship.
