
WSS Superstar SCOPE Champions!

7. It all started with: To create a comic strip on SDG@8(Virtual event)



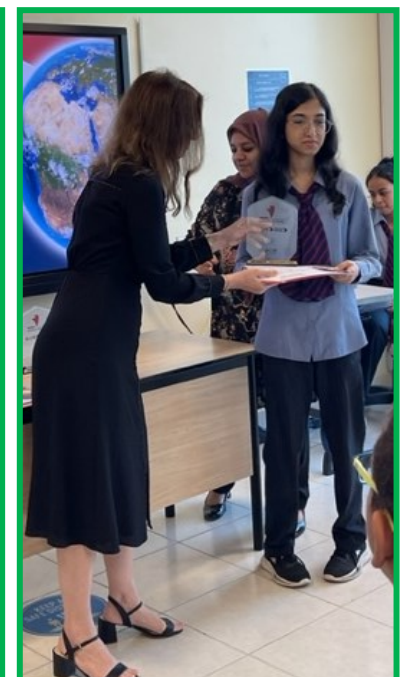

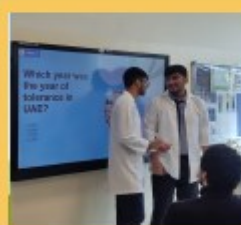
