


Message from the Principal/CEO Ms. Valerie Thompson

initiatives that take place at WSS each week, designed to take your child's learning to the next level.



This F2F meeting was arranged in response to parent feedback which expressed their desire to meet their teachers in person. It was not a 'off day' for students; accompanying their parents to meet their teachers in person as a family, sends a powerful message of home-school teamwork around the child, & that the child has a responsibility for self-development within the learning triangle of home-school-child. Discussions around their strengths, targets, learning journey, attainment & progress are very powerful to boost motivation & application.

Parents who were unable to attend are most welcome to schedule a later TEAMS or F2F meeting with their teachers.

Home-school meetings can always be arranged through the teacher directly, or through the PRE Ms. Aiysha as required.

WSS SLT & MLT representatives attended the recent SPEA British Curriculum schools SIA Ms. Lynn's 'Excellence Day' on 17/1/23. The day was designed for Principals & Senior S\leaders to share expertise and attend workshops on the latest development in education as presented by Oxford. Thank you SPEA for outing on tis event to support school development.

Ms. Sreeja, Assistant Principal, Secondary, shared that they were able to meet with our SPEA School Improvement Advisor (SIA) Ms. Lynn & GEMS Principal & our LAB (Local Advisory Body) member Ms. Albie. It was a very productive day.

Some of the programme details were as follows:

Dr. Jonathan Osborne's session discussed 'Challenges and New Directions in Science Education.'

We understood how just knowledge is not enough to sustain good teaching. How can we build more trust in Science education by removing unnecessary myths in science?

The discussion also included the importance of building the reliability of the search engines used by students during research.

The most significant bit was about the new skill that would be tested in the following PISA (2025): the ability to research, evaluate and use scientific information for decision-making.

- There was an exciting session on strategies to accelerate reading skills by Mr. Paul Woodfall. He recommended multiple exciting strategies to improve reading skills, like habit formation, reading circles, perspectivetaking, etc.
- Some other sessions included strategies to embed well-being across the school and how to engage six-year-olds to be taught about sustainability and climate change.



Secondary Section News; PASS Assessment & PASS Data Application!

Students recently undertaking PASS Assessments. While CAT4 & GL Progress Tests provide us with academic-type data, PASS provides data of an attitudinal and social nature. Since learning occurs most effectively when a student is positively motivated & has a positive self-learner image, it is helpful to school that we have this holistic data. Data provides information on social and personal areas that school can promote to improve the personalisation of our students learning & wellbeing. One of our school development priorities is the identification & support for 'Fragile learners'. PASS data tells the students' social story, helping educators identify and support fragile learners whose achievement is held back by factors such as a lack of confidence, motivation, or connection to school.

Arshaq (Y13BH) said, "(This) Survey gave students an idea about (their own) well-being and health."



- 2. To give students a sense of control over thinking & learning, promote deep learning and make them active learners.


Section Heads had provided a session to teachers, who led the sessions in their Form Class.




Secondary Section News; Sixth Form Admission Session!
