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#### Whole School News; Health & Safety; Medicines in School!

Please do not send medicines to school with your child without following the below policy to ensure the health & safety of all our students.

It is very important teat medicines are never shared with classmates/friends/others in school (such as Brufen, Panadol etc as others may have an allergic reaction or overdose).

#### Medicines:

- Students are not permitted to carry medicine with them around school under any circumstances.
- If your child needs medication at school, please hand it to the Clinic where it will be stored safely. Your
  child will be required to come to the clinic at the appropriate time to take it.
- You must also inform the Clinic if any medicine may be needed at the school for an existing condition such as an inhaler for asthma, insulin for diabetes, or an Epipen for allergies.
- After the treatment period, any remaining Medicine must be collected by parent/Guardian from the Clinic. If uncollected after one week it would be discarded through Wekaya.
- Please complete & submit the Medicine Consent Form as required (collect from the Clinic).





The Principal attended the SEA/SPEA Sharjah Education Academy International Summit on Improvement in Education on 26/2/24.
