

<u>Uniform</u>

We are training our students to become successful, professional 'business people', so enforce a smart uniform code to reinforce self-discipline, professionalism, equality, personal pride & a sense of belonging to a team. Wearing our full uniform & ID badge is compulsory. We request that parents support our uniform code.

- Full school uniform including ID Badge should be worn to school daily. Not wearing
 proper school uniform is a disciplinary issue.
- If due to some unavoidable reason your child is not in proper uniform, please write a Planner note/send an email to your child's Class/Form Teacher. Thank you.
- On PE days, the PE Uniform may be worn to school (with ID Badge).
- Birthday children may wear their dress-up clothes to school for that day.
- · Full school uniform should be worn for trips, unless otherwise informed by the Teacher.
- Parents can purchase approved uniform from Threads. Threads Contact is Tel: 8008473237, www.threadsme.com).
- · The school Bookstore keeps a stock of ties & scarves for convenient replacement.
- · Replacement ID cards can be purchased from the BBT office

Please note our uniform policy (see also Threads Uniform poster below):

- Abaya: A plain navy blue or black Abaya may be worn if required for religious or cultural reasons
- Art overall: It is recommended to bring an art overall for Art lessons.
- Bags: Wheeled trolley bags are not allowed (in FS1-Y2 for this academic year, & from September 2023 for all students). Please send a small, cubby-hole sized backpack for Juniors.
- Belt: A uniform belt is available if required
- Blazer: Optional
- Headscarf/shehla: Students may wear the uniform version (pale blue), or plain white/black (absolutely no decoration).
- Hair: Long hair (touching the shoulder & longer) should be tied back with uniform ties/headband

Whole School News; SPEA SPR Inspection Report, 2023!

Please find below a summary of the identified key strengths & areas for improvement, as outlined in our SPR inspection Report. School will be working on an Action Plan with students, LAB team & leaders at all levels to plan next step strategies for even further improvement.

Overview of Progress from 2017-2018 to 2022-2023

- √ There was an improvement across ALL 6 Performance Standards from 2017/2018.
- √ Overall, there is a 64-point increase in performance indicators across all 4 phases.
- In 2017/2018, 79 performance indicators were judged.
- √ In 2022/23, MOST (60 out of 79 = 76%) of the performance indicators have improved by at least 1 point.
- √ In 2022/23, 4 of the performance indicators have improved by 2 points:
 - Mathematics attainment across phase 1
 - Mathematics attainment across phase 3
 - Partnerships with parents and the community
 - o Governance
- In 2022/23 the school has been judged on 107 performance indicators across all phases.
- MOST (93 out of 107 = 87%) of the performance indicators are at Good or above.
- ✓ Phase 1: A Majority (10 out of 18 = 56%) of the performance indicators have improved in 2022/23
- ✓ Phase 2: Almost All (20 out of 22 = 91%) of the performance indicators have improved in 2022/23
- Phase 3: Most (18 out of 22 = 82%) of the performance indicators have improved in 2022/23
- √ Phase 4: A Large Majority (8 out of 12 = 67%) of the performance indicators have improved in 2022/23

KEY AREAS OF STRENGTH:

- The provision and outcomes for children in the Foundation Stage which build very good foundations for later learning.
- The overall improvement in students' achievement across the curriculum, particularly in mathematics in Phase 3.
- The provision to identify and support students with special educational needs.
- Students' positive behaviour and very good attitudes to learning.
- The improvement in teaching and learning across the school.
- The very good provision for the safeguarding, care and wellbeing of students.
- The identification of key leadership roles to impact upon achievement.

KEY AREAS FOR IMPROVEMENT:

- Students' achievement in social studies, Arabic first language and Islamic Education in Phase 4 and in Arabic second language in Phases 3 and 4.
- The consistency of challenge in lessons for all students, especially higher-attainers.
- Increased opportunities for innovative activities in regular lessons across the school.
- More structured provision for the varied needs of gifted and talented students across the school.
- Students' punctuality when arriving to school at the start of the school day.
