The school's dedication to providing these resources and ensuring my comfort and safety made a tremendous difference in my recovery process.

I extend my heartfelt thanks to all my friends, teachers, staff members, and the entire GEMS Westminster School Sharjah community for their unwavering support and assistance throughout this challenging period. Their collective efforts made a positive impact on my overall experience and helped me overcome the difficulties I faced.

The empathy and assistance extended to me during my time in a wheelchair were truly invaluable.
