WSS Superstar Environment & Recycling Champions!

On average, a UAE resident generates 17.2 kg of e-waste per annum, much of which ends up in landfill sites where it can negatively impact the environment and local wildlife. WSS will be participating in an e-waste recycling campaign. This campaign aims to collect e-waste (old or broken mobile phones, laptops, tablets, and smartwatches) from the GEMS community so that it can be safely disposed of. Please note that devices will not be repurposed or sold. Fixerman will weigh each collection box to measure how much has been collected from each school. The year-long campaign and donations will be collected beginning next week and continuing through May 2023.

How the campaign works:

1. We will shortly receive a Fixerman e-recycling bin, made from recycled cardboard. It will be placed in an accessible location.

- 2. All personal files should be deleted from the device, and data will be erased by E-Scrappy before recycling.
- **3.** The Fixerman van will collect the donated devices every week from school.
- 4. All discarded devices will be safely destroyed and disposed of through Dubai Municipality-registered recycling company <u>E-Scrappy</u>.

What devices can be collected?

Mobile phones, tablets, laptops and smartwatches. Please note that <u>chargers, batteries and leads cannot be collected for disposal</u>.







