Immerse Education and Competition My Personal Experience – by Haya Mutasim Year12 GF

Details:

Immerse Education was founded in 2012 to provide students aged 13-18 with unparalleled educational experiences. They have educated thousands of students through exceptional academic enrichment programmes in the colleges of Oxford and Cambridge University, University College London and the University of Sydney. The Immerse Education Blog Competition allows students aged 13-18 to write a blog about a pre-set topic. Topics included were:

- Is morality related to the level of education of a person?
- What has been the biggest impact of technology to date, and why?
- What tips and advice would you give to younger students studying for exams?

Winners are awarded the Blog Prize Award, which is a scholarship to study their chosen subject led by professors from Oxford, Cambridge, and Ivy League Universities with Immerse in one of their Online Insights or Online Research Programme (Intensive, Classic or Extensive). The blog article must have a 500-word limit.

Motivation for Joining:

I've always had a keen eye for writing; the word choices, the tone of the text, and the overall delivery. I intended to challenge my writing skills by entering this international blog writing competition, and the sole reason why I was captivated was the topic, 'What tips and advice would you give to younger students studying for exams?' I believe that this topic must be under discussion due to many of our fellow students' numerous misconceptions about achieving success. Their perception of what hard work means is primarily the cause of their burnout; hence, I intended to challenge that misconception and argue that hard work is more than that in my blog. I had to learn the hard way, enduring a gruesome routine of doing past papers daily with minimal breaks. It affected my mental health tremendously. And with that, I found myself lying in bed with no motivation or drive to study, even though I had an important board exam that week. This isn't a unique experience; instead, it is a common theme amongst high school students to expose themselves to the manifestation of burnout.

I want to remind my fellow peers and future students that achieving success is possible without sacrificing their health and wellbeing. I'm passionate about relieving them of this misconception and broadening their perspective of hard work. Through personal trials and errors, I crafted this blog to inspire students to develop a healthy relationship with learning.

Thought Process in Crafting the Blog:

The concept I focused on throughout my blog is the corrupted learning mindset we grew up with. The mindset that tells us that the only way to get perfect scores is to spend hours on end studying and solving past papers whilst sacrificing our sleep and meals. In my introductory paragraph, I provided an example such as 'waking up at 4 a.m. and solving past papers for the next 10 hours with little rest daily,' which is essentially implying that students tend to misinterpret 'no sacrifice, no success' as an indication that it's okay to risk their emotional well-being and physical health for the sake of scoring an A*. I argued in my blog that the sacrifices we must make are associated with distractions that stray us from effectively learning. These distractions include social media platforms such as Instagram and Tik Tok that target young audiences to feed on their content for hours without perceiving wasted time.

I proceed with my body paragraph by highlighting the importance of targeting one's weakest points, as students tend to set aside the topics they find the most challenging and focus on the ones they find the most manageable and most enjoyable, which is a mechanism student frequently use to prevent demotivation. And to target those weak points, I mentioned various initiatives that students could take, such as incorporating practical study sessions, targeting their mistakes and learning from them, and actively recalling their topics. I then kept my concluding paragraph short and direct by highlighting the correct perception of productivity that students must realize to prevent burnout.

I incorporated numerous linguistic features to make my blog impactful such as quotes by Mark Twain and Brianna West, as well as rhetorical questions in my introductory paragraph, inclusive words such as "I" and "you" to provide a sense of interaction with the audience, word choices such as "beats" which reflects a semi-formal tone to resonate with the young audience, and sequencing discourse markers such as "to start" to organize my ideas.

Thoughts on Winning:

By the will of Allah, I was able to win this international award along with other passionate writers across the globe, and it makes me proud to know that my blog is one of the highest calibers of entries of the year 2023.

I intend to continue reflecting on my values and teaching the future batch of students the open-minded meaning of hard work to enable them to achieve their desired grades without sacrificing their happiness.

And I'm extremely grateful for my English teacher Ms. Ayesha Aslam for teaching me the elements of blog writing, including the structure and the various linguistic features incorporated to make it as influential and effectual as possible!

The Blog; How to Beat the Corrupted Learning Mindset

When studying for exams, many students believe that the key to getting perfect scores is to exceed the limits of their psychological and physiological well-being—waking up at 4 a.m. and solving past papers for the next 10 hours with little rest daily. It's unfathomable to think that this is what students perceive as "hard work," yet simultaneously try to mask their exhaustion by assuring themselves that it'll all be worth it. However, is this truly the most effective approach for achieving academic success? Or is there a more innovative way to study that leads to better outcomes and overall well-being? In this blog, I intend to challenge the misconception that hard work means sacrificing your well-being and personal life. Instead, I argue that genuine hard work moreover involves determination and consistency whilst also knowing when to take breaks and employing practical study sessions; it's also taking care of yourself, allowing yourself to



breathe fresh air and doing something you love in between to remind you that life isn't all about grades. So how would one achieve the correct perception of 'hard work' I speak of? Well, you've come to the right place if you'd like to find out.

To start, I'd like to shed light on a quote by Mark Twain; he mentions: "If it's your job to eat two frogs, it's best to eat the biggest one first," which is essentially telling us to focus on the complex topics first, no need to waste time repeating topics you already know, instead, focus on the most challenging tasks to make time your friend. More often, students push those topics aside and concentrate on what they're good at to prevent demotivation. Yet, students are invariably struck with a reality check once they see the question in the exam paper. Hence, it's always good to ask yourself, "If the exam were tomorrow, what topic would I feel the least happy about coming up in the exam?" This is a rather revealing question to find transparency within yourself; it allows you to target your weak points and eliminate them, thus leading to my next point; practical study sessions, which, according to Newport (2007), will enable the student to accomplish more when studying intensively for shorter periods with minimal wasted efforts. An effective formula for success involves solving past papers, focusing on your mistakes, actively recalling concepts by testing yourself, and mastering the ability to eliminate all distractions, including numerous social platforms, for extended periods. This beats spending hours reading through past papers and ineffectively reviewing them.

With this in mind, I want you to stop limiting yourself to believing that you must sacrifice your happiness to become successful. Drop the false perception of productivity because, as Brianna West once said, "Some days, you'll get it all done. Some days, you need rest. Some days, just getting one thing checked off the list is reason enough to feel proud of yourself." Doing so can build a healthy relationship with learning, as you should.


