We wish you all the very best and hope you have a wonderful and relaxing summer break.

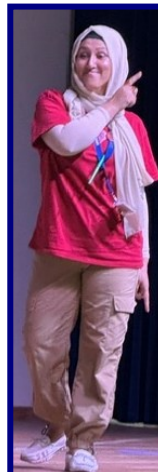
